Bio:

Amad Tayebi is a professor of Plastics Engineering at the University of Massachusetts Lowell. He joined the Plastics Engineering Department in 1978. Before that, he was an Assistant/Associate Professor at Georgia Institute of Technology from 1973 to 1978.

He holds a B.Sc. with Highest Honors, in Textile Engineering, from Alexandria University, a Masters Degree, a Mechanical Engineer Degree and a Doctor of Science Degree, with a major in Mechanical Engineering and a Minor in Chemical Engineering, from M.I.T. He also holds a Juris Doctor Degree from Massachusetts School of Law. He is a Massachusetts Attorney and a Patent Attorney licensed to practice Patent Law before the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office.

He is the recipient of Outstanding Teacher Award at Georgia Institute of Technology (1976), Excellence in Teaching Award at the University of Massachusetts Lowell (1998), (2000), (2002), (2005) and (2008) and the U-Mass Lowell Student Government Association Exceeding Expectations Award (2004).

In 1984, he co-founded and was Chairman of the Board of Better Breathing, Inc. (BBI) which was a company that designed, manufactured and sold NIOSH-approved disposable respirators. He left BBI in 1999.

He provided expert testimony and opinion in a number of Product Liability and Patent Infringement cases.

He authored numerous technical and law publications. He also authored 24 U.S. Patents and 4 foreign patents.
